Welcome to our company. Let me introduce you to your supervisor. Vic, this is Carmen Martinez. She's a new employee. Please give her an orientation to the company.





We take fifteen minute breaks twice a day, mid-morning and mid-afternoon. We seldom take our breaks before ten a.m. or after four p.m.







